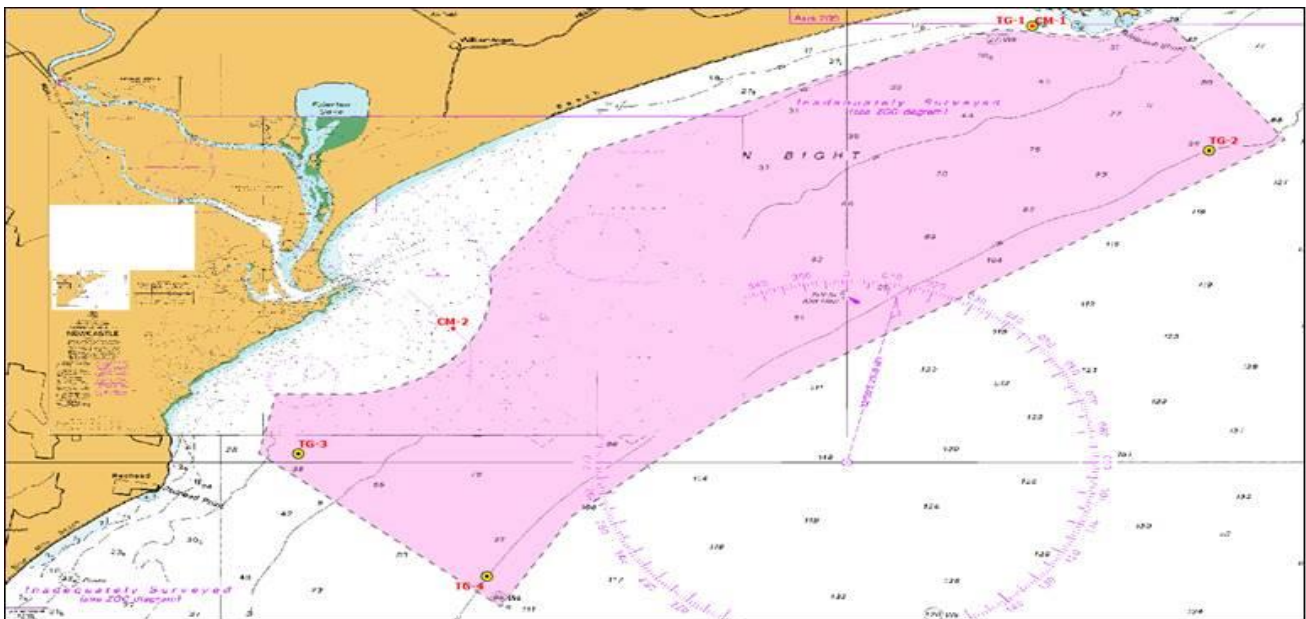


Notice to Mariners

Hydrographic Survey - Approaches to Newcastle

Mariners are advised that Hydrographic survey operations will be carried from 5th – 30th December 2020 to the approaches to Newcastle as per chart let below.



Survey Vessel Offshore Guardian L.O.A 34 Meters Beam 11.0 Meters, will be restricted in her ability to maneuver during the operation and shall exhibit the light and shapes as prescribed in COLREGS/ Marine order 30. Vessel will maintain a listening watch on Ch 16/09.



Additionally, temporary tidal recording equipment is being deployed from 05th December to 11th January 2021
