## White Bay Cruise Terminal Function Performance Report

Year 1 Trial Period

February 2023

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## 1 Background

### 1.1 Introduction

The White Bay Cruise Terminal (WBCT) is a purpose-built cruise passenger terminal located at White Bay Wharf 5 (WB5), with secondary berthing at White Bay Wharf 4 (WB4).
On the 2 February 2011, the former Sydney Ports Corporation (now Port Authority of NSW) received approval for Major Project 10_0069 under Part 3A (now repealed) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 (EP\&A Act) to demolish an assortment of buildings and structures on the site, construct the White Bay Cruise Terminal (WBCT) and internal access road, operate the facility with berthing for up to two cruise ships, with the second ship serviced by a temporary terminal facility at WB4, and the use of the WBCT for functions, exhibitions and corporate events on non-cruise ship days (Note: the Major Project 10_0069 approval was transitioned to Division 5.2 Part 5 of the EP\&A Act on 31 May 2019, and is referred to in this OEMP as the Project Approval).

The WBCT was constructed during 2012 and the first quarter of 2013 and the then Sydney Ports Corporation commenced cruise operations at the WBCT in April 2013.

Port Authority of New South Wales (the Port Authority) was established in July 2014 with the amalgamation of the Sydney, Newcastle and Port Kembla Port Corporations. Port Authority retained the significant maritime roles of Harbour Master, management of dangerous goods and emergency response plus responsibility for the navigation, security and operational safety needs of commercial shipping operating on Sydney Harbour. The Port Authority, which is a state-owned corporation, also owns and operates the WBCT.

Relevant to the Functions use of the WBCT, a modification was approved on 27 August 2020 (MOD 6) allowing an increase in the number of attendees at functions from 500 to a maximum of 2,500 patrons at any one time during a 3 -year trial period and at the completion of the trial period as required under MP 10_0069. In accordance with the Project Approval, the Functions OEMP was updated to address the requirements of MOD 6 and the OEMP was approved by DPE in January 2022. The approved Functions OEMP is available on the Port Authority's website: https://www.portauthoritynsw.com.au/media/5257/wbct-funtions-oemp-jan-22-complete.pdf.

The first function over 500 patrons at the WBCT was undertaken on 30 November 2021, which triggered the commencement of the 3 -year trial period for functions between 501 and 2,500 patrons.

This Report, covering the period 30 November 2021 to 30 November 2022, is the first annual Function Performance Report for the 3 -year trial period. This Function Performance Report has been prepared in accordance with the Conditions detailed in A11 to A19 of the consolidated conditions of the Project Approval.

## 2 Trial Period

### 2.1 Condition A11

'The Proponent may hold functions between 501 and 2,500 patrons, for a trial period of three years from a date notified by the Proponent to the Planning Secretary, unless otherwise agreed by the Planning Secretary.'

In accordance with this condition, Port Authority notified the Planning Secretary of the commencement of the 3 -year trial period, from 30 November 2021, the first date a function with over 500 patrons was planned to be held. See Appendix A for Port Authority's letter to the Planning Secretary, dated 26 November 2021.

As indicated above, this report covers the first 12-months of the trial period, from the 30 November 2021 to 30 November 2022.

### 2.2 Condition A12

'During the three-year trial period, the Proponent must hold a minimum of two functions within each of the following trial function categories:

### 2.3 Condition A13

'For each trial function category identified in Condition A12, a minimum of two types of functions must be held, such as an indoor function, an outdoor function in the WB4 hardstand area and/or WB5 car park, or an indoor and outdoor function in the WB4 hardstand area and/or WB5 car park.'

The following type of functions were held for each of the following trial function categories in the first year of reporting:

Two types of functions were held for the small trial function category.

### 2.4 Condition A14

'If the minimum number of trial functions identified in condition A12 are not held during the three-year trial period, the trial period for these types of trial functions continues until such time they are held.'

As shown in Section 2.3, two types of small trial functions were held during Year 1 of the 3-year trial period. If the minimum number of trial functions identified in condition A12 are not held in the 3-year trial period, then the trial period for these types of trial functions would continue until such time they are held.

### 2.5 Condition A15

'The Proponent must prepare a Function Performance Report at the conclusion of each 12-month period (reporting period) of the trial period, or at such other times as directed by the Planning Secretary. The Function Performance Report must be submitted to the Planning Secretary no later than one month following each reporting period.'

In accordance with Condition A15, this Function Performance Report was prepared at the conclusion of the first 12-month period (reporting period) of the trial period.

### 2.6 Condition A17

'A copy of each Function Performance Report must be provided to the Council, EPA, TfNSW and the Community Liaison Group within one month of the end of the reporting period and made publicly available on the Proponent's website.'

In accordance with Condition A17, a copy of this Function Performance Report will be provided to the Council, EPA, TfNSW and the Community Liaison Group for their information and made publicly available on Port Authority of NSW's website.

### 2.7 Condition A18

'Should the minimum trial function requirements identified in Condition A12 not occur during the trial period, then Function Performance Reports must continue to be prepared in accordance with conditions A15 and A16. The Function Performance Reports must be submitted to the Planning Secretary within one month following the holding of such trial functions.'

In accordance with Condition A18, if the minimum trial function requirements identified in Condition A12 do not occur during the 3 year trial period, then Function Performance Reports will continue to be prepared in subsequent years in accordance with conditions A15 and A16.

### 2.8 Condition A19

'Following the completion of the trial period incorporating a minimum of two types of functions in each trial function category, the Proponent may seek the Planning Secretary's approval to:
a) continue holding functions equivalent to the trial function categories that were held during the trial period;
b) permit functions that are likely to generate audible noise at any sensitive receiver to the hours of 7:00 am to 12:00 midnight, 4 days in any week (Conditions D6); and
c) permit an increase in the noise level of background music played in the area on the southern side of the terminal building to no more than 72 dBA (Condition D10).'

Port Authority is in the second year of the 3-year trial period, and therefore this condition is not yet applicable.

## 3 Function Performance Report

### 3.1 Condition A16

The requirements of condition A 16 are addressed in Table 1 below.

Condition D12 states that 'Noise monitoring must be carried out for functions incorporating amusement rides or similar activities, and outdoor activities in the WB4 hardstand area and/or WB5 car park from 6:00 pm and up to 12:30 am.'
c) a comparison of the environmental impacts and performance of the trial function against the environmental impacts and performance predicted in the documents listed in condition A1 and as modified by conditions of this approval;

## Assessment of performance

An assessment of the trial function's performance and compliance with the (relevant) terms of this approval has been assessed in this table (Table 1) and Table 2 below.

Functions over 500 people in the first-year trial have complied with the relevant terms of this approval.
In summary, six small trial functions (between 501 and 1000 patrons) were successfully held during the first year of the trial period. These functions were compliant with the Project Approval and the approved Functions OEMP. No environmental or amenity issues occurred during the functions. No complaints were received in relation to any of these functions.

Six small functions were held during this first-year trial period. No noise monitoring was required for these six functions, as they did not trigger Condition D12. I.e., These functions did not incorporate amusement rides or similar activities and there were no outdoor activities in the WB4 hardstand area and/or WB5 car park from 6:00 pm and up to 12:30 am.

## Assessment of performance

The functions during the first-year trial showed no environmental or amenity impacts. No traffic or noise impacts occurred during these functions. No complaints were received in relation to any of the functions.

All environmental performance requirements for the trial function have been met There have been no environmental or amenity impact, incidents or noncompliances with the conditions of approval during this trial period.

As indicated above, no noise monitoring was required during the first year of the trial period. During this first-year trial period, the following is noted:

- No complaints were received associated with any of the functions
- There were no traffic or parking issues in any of the functions, including no adverse reporting from the $24 / 7$ security gate at the port access road to the WBCT or other stakeholders.
- There were no structures at any of these events.

There were no amusement rides or similar outdoor activities.

- There were no functions or activities held outdoors in the WB4 hardstand area or WB5 car park past 6 pm . The requirement for noise monitoring of the
