

## Harbour Master Approval Process

*Note: This process is only to be used where a Port Authority of New South Wales Permission to Lodge approval is not required.*

### Step 1

Contact the relevant Port Authority of NSW Harbour Master to discuss any proposed works that may disturb the bed of a port and require approval under Section 110 of the *Ports and Maritime Administration Regulation 2021*.

Applicant received formal determination from the Harbour Master.
